Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1112.

Amend House Bill No. 1112 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 5 and substitute the following: "By: Representatives Agee, Pritchard, Biggs, Bledsoe, Haak, C. Johnson,"

AND

AND

Page 1, delete line 25 and substitute the following: "<u>early voting location</u>, beginning fifteen (15) days before an <u>a primary</u>, <u>run</u>off, or general election and"

AND

Page 1, delete line 30 and substitute the following: "(2) However, on all other elections, early voting shall be available to any qualified elector who applies to the county clerk during regular office hours, beginning fifteen (15) days before an election and ending on the day before the election day at the time the county clerk's office regularly closes.

(b)(1)(A) In any county containing one hundred fifty thousand"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 34 and 35 and substitute the following: "locations for a maximum of fifteen (15) days but fewer if it so chooses by a majority vote <u>on any of the days and times provided for in § 7-5-418(a), if</u> they so choose."
