Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1129.

Amend House Bill No. 1129 as engrossed, H1/30/03:

Page 1, delete lines 22, and substitute the following:
 "(b)(1) If a A voter shall informs inform the election officials at
the time the voter presents himself or herself to vote that he or she is"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 29 and 30, and substitute the following: "(B) A person named by the voter."

AND

Page 1, delete line 34, and substitute the following: "voter without comment or interpretation."

AND

Page 1, delete line 35 through 36, and substitute the following: "(3) If the voter is assisted by one (1) person named by the voter, he or she may assist the voter in marking the ballot according to the wishes of the voter without any comment or interpretation."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 2.

AND

Page 2, delete lines 10 through 22, substitute the following: "(2) When any qualified elector notifies as election official at the voting precinct that he or she is unable to read the ballot, the election official shall cause the entire ballot to be read to the voter, unless the voter instructs otherwise. The election official shall then assist the voter



without comment or interpretation in marking the ballot. (3) If the voter designates a person to assist, the election official shall allow that person to assist the voter, an the person designated shall read the entire ballot to the voter, unless the voter instructs otherwise, and then assist the voter without comment or interpretation in marking the ballot."
