AND

Page 2, line 5 add "mere" after "distributor's" and before "placement"

AND

Page 2, delete line 15 and substitute "<u>by the discharge of a firearm, non-</u>powder gun or ammunition, unless the action alleges that the physical or <u>emotional injury</u>, physical damage, or death was caused by the intentional or <u>negligent discharge of a firearm</u>, non-powder gun or ammunition by the <u>manufacturer</u>, importer, or dealer."
