**Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1345.**

Amend House Bill No. 1345 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 22 through 29 and substitute the following:

(e)(1) The county recorder may maintain a record book that contains  
any of the following information about veterans for public record:

(A) Name;

(B) Rank;

(C) Unit of military service;

(D) Dates of military service;

(E) Medals conferred upon the veteran; and

(F) Awards conferred upon the veteran.

(2) If the county recorder does not maintain a record book,  
then, upon specific request for the information, the county recorder shall  
review a military service discharge record or DD Form 214 and provide only  
the information in subdivision (e)(1) of this section to the requestor,  
without allowing the requestor to review the military service discharge  
record or DD Form 214.
