Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1477.

Amend House Bill No. 1477 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-26-306 is amended to read as follows: 5-26-306. Aggravated assault on a family or household member. (a) A person commits aggravated assault on a family or household member if, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he purposely engages in conduct that creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to a family or household member.						
(b) <u>(l)</u> Aggravated assault on a family or household member is a Class D						
felony.						
(2) Aggravated assault on a family or household member is a						
Class C felony if within the past five (5) years, the person:						
(A) Plead guilty or nolo contendere to, or has been found						
guilty of:						
(i) Domestic battering in the first degree; (ii) Domestic battering in the second degree; (iii) Domestic battering in the third degree; (iv) Aggravated assault on a family or household						
member; or						
(v) First degree assault on a family or household						
member; or (B) Violated an equivalent penal law of another state or						
foreign jurisdiction.						

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-26-307 is amended to read as follows: 5-26-307. First degree assault on family or household member.

(a) A person commits first degree assault on a family or household member if he recklessly engages in conduct which creates a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to a family or household member.

(b)(1) First degree assault on a family or household member is a Class A misdemeanor.

(2) First degree assault on a family or household member is a Class D felony if within the past five (5) years, the person:



(A) Plead guilty or nolo contendere to, or has been found guilty of:
