Insert an additional section immediately following SECTION 13 to read as follows:

" SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>POOL</u> <u>POSITIONS. (a) The Department of Information Systems shall establish and</u> <u>maintain for the 2003-2005 biennium a pool of 25 positions, payable from</u> <u>funds appropriated herein for such purposes and not to exceed the rates of</u> <u>pay authorized in section 1 of this Act or in the Uniform Classification and</u> <u>Compensation Act. These positions are to be used to provide new or expanded</u> <u>data processing and telecommunications services in the event the personnel</u> <u>services of the Department of Information Systems exceed the number of</u> <u>positions allocated for the 2003-2005 biennium. No classification, grade or</u> <u>salary level will be assigned to the pool positions until such time as</u> <u>specific positions are requested by the Department of Information Systems,</u> <u>recommended by the Office of Personnel Management and after receiving prior</u> <u>review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.</u>

(b) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the Maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has determined that the Department of Information Systems could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing pool positions in subsection (a) of this section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the pool position concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the pool positions by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the entire section is void. If the agency requests continuation of this pool of positions as established herein during the next biennium, the positions must be requested as new positions in the agency's biennial budget request.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.
