Subtitle of House Bill No. 2221

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL TRAFFIC CITATIONS ISSUED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES
OF A MUNICIPALITY TO BE DOCKETED IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THAT
MUNICIPALITY."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2221.

Amend House Bill No. 2221 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11 add "OR CITY" after "DISTRICT"

AND

Page 1, line 18 add "OR CITY" after "DISTRICT"

AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. (a) All traffic citations issued within the boundaries of a municipality of this state which has a district or city court shall be placed on the docket of the district or city court of that municipality, unless the presiding judge of that court authorizes a transfer to another court exercising jurisdiction over the area in which the citation was issued.

(b) If a municipality has more than one court exercising subject matter jurisdiction over traffic citations issued within the boundaries of that municipality, then all traffic citations issued within the boundaries of that municipality shall be placed on the docket of the court in the closest proximity to where the offense occurred."
