## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2274.

Amend House Bill No. 2274 as originally introduced:

Add Representative J. Johnson as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 2, line 2, delete "<u>the policy be</u>" and substitute "<u>notice of what</u> <u>constitutes bullying, that bullying is prohibited</u>, and the consequences of <u>engaging in bullying be</u>"

AND

Page 2, line 5, delete "<u>policy to be</u>" and substitute "<u>notice of what</u> <u>constitutes bullying, that bullying is prohibited</u>, and the consequences of <u>engaging in bullying be</u>"

AND

Page 2, line 6, delete "<u>and employees.</u>" and substitute "<u>and employees. The</u> <u>policies shall require that full copies of the policy must be made available</u> upon request."

AND

Page 2, line 8, delete "cause of action" and substitute "tort liability"

AND

Page 2, line 20, insert the following:

"SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1005(a)(5), pertaining to student services programs to be provided by school guidance and counseling services, is amended to read as follows:

(5) Group conflict resolution services, which shall include, but are not limited to, the following:



(A) Educational and social programs which help students develop skills enabling them to resolve differences and conflicts between groups; and

(B) Programs designed to promote understanding, positive communication, and a greater utilization of a race relations specialist or human relations specialist to assist in the development of intergroup skills; and

(C) Programs designed to prevent bullying."
