## Subtitle of House Bill No. 2556

"AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING PROCEDURES FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF UNFAIR HOUSING PRACTICES."

## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2556.

Amend House Bill No. 2556 as originally introduced:

Page 5, line 2, delete "(\$1000,000)" and substitute "(\$100,000)"

AND

Insert an additional section immediately following Section 12 to read as follows:

"SECTION 13. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the provisions of this act are</u> <u>designed to comply with the federal Fair Housing Law, and to make the state</u> <u>eligible for federal funds; that until this act becomes law those federal</u> <u>funds will not be available to the State of Arkansas; and therefore, this act</u> <u>should go into effect as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is</u> <u>declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the</u> <u>preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective</u> <u>on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
