"TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE TO ACKNOWLEDGE THEIR PUBLIC SERVICE."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2618.

Amend House Bill No. 2618 as engrossed, h3/26/03:

Page 4, line 18, add a new section to the bill to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that, at this time of national</u> <u>emergency with American troops engaged in combat in Iraq, it is important for</u> <u>the State of Arkansas to promote organizations that stand for American values</u> <u>and public service; that the Boy Scouts of America advocate the highest of</u> <u>standards of ideals for American youth; that the Boy Scouts of America need</u> <u>the moral support of the community and the financial support from this</u> <u>license plate for their programs to promote those American ideals; that the</u> <u>issuance of the special license plate to honor the Boy Scouts of America will</u> <u>promote those goals; and that this act is immediately necessary because this</u> <u>is a unique time in American history with our nation at war. Therefore, an</u> <u>emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for</u> <u>the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become</u> <u>effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
