"AN ACT TO REQUIRE POLITICAL PARTIES AND LEGISLATIVE POLITICAL PARTY CAUCUSES TO REPORT CAMPAIGN RELATED EXPENDITURES."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2763.

Amend House Bill No. 2763 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 22 through 30 and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-223 is amended to read as follows: 7-6-223. Reports of contributions by political parties. (a)(1) Organized political parties Within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each calendar quarter, each political party as defined in § 7-1-101(16) shall file an annual a quarterly report with the Secretary of State no later than January 15 of each year beginning in 1998, providing the name, address, employer, and occupation of each person who made a contribution or contributions to the political party or any authorized committee, which in the aggregate exceeded two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) fifty dollars (\$50.00) in the preceding calendar year quarter. (2) The report shall include: (A) the The date and amount of each such contribution-; (B) The total amount of money disbursed by the political party; and (C) An itemization including the amount of the disbursement, the name and address of the person to whom the disbursement was made, and the date the disbursement was made for each single disbursement that exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100). (b)(1) Within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each calendar quarter, each political party caucus of the General Assembly, the Senate, or the House of Representatives shall file a quarterly report with the Secretary of State providing the name, address, employer, and occupation of each person who made a contribution or contributions to the political party caucus, that in the aggregate exceeded fifty dollars (\$50.00) in the preceding calendar quarter. (2) The report shall include: (A) The date and amount of each contribution; (B) The total amount of money disbursed by the political

party caucus; and

(C) An itemization including the amount of the disbursement, the name and address of the person to whom the disbursement was



made, and the date the disbursement was made for each single disbursement that exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100)."
