"SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 23-17-409(a), authorizing competing local exchange carriers, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) Consistent with the federal act and the provisions of § 23-17-410, the Arkansas Public Service Commission is authorized to grant certificates of convenience and necessity to telecommunications providers authorizing them to provide <u>telecommunications services including</u> basic local exchange service or switched-access service, or both, to an incumbent local exchange carrier's local exchange area if and to the extent that the applications otherwise comply with state law, designate the geographic areas proposed to be served by the applicants, and the applicants demonstrate they possess the financial, technical, and managerial capacity to provide the competing services.

(B) No telecommunications provider shall operate as a CLEC in this state without first obtaining from the commission a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

(2) Competing local exchange carriers shall be required to maintain a current tariff or price list with the commission and to make prices and terms of service available for public inspection.

(3) Retail prices of competing local exchange carriers shall not require prior review or approval by the commission.
