Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 11.

Amend Senate Bill No. 11 as engrossed, S1/21/03:

Page 2, line 19, add an additional section to read as follows:

SECTION 3. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain state employees with</u> <u>severe illnesses are being denied time off to deal with those illnesses; that</u> <u>the employees are in dire need of relief from the strict requirements of the</u> <u>catastrophic leave law; that by denying them the time off an unnecessary</u> <u>hardship has befallen those public employees; and that this act is</u> <u>immediately necessary because of the immediate need for time off for those</u> <u>employees. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being</u> <u>immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and</u> <u>safety shall become effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
