Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 691.

Amend Senate Bill No. 691 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 7 delete "district"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 10 though 15 and substitute the following: (2)(A) If the State Board of Education determines that a public school teacher teaching grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12) had sexual contact with a student enrolled in the same school in which the teacher is employed as a teacher, the teacher shall not thereafter be eligible for employment by any school in this state. (B) This subdivision (d)(2) applies even if the sexual contact does not violate the Arkansas Criminal Code, § 5-1-101 et seq."
