Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 722.

Amend Senate Bill No. 722 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 31, delete "(B)" and substitute "(B)(i)"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 16 through 18 and substitute the following: "(B)(i) Exempt an applicant for a pharmacist license, who upon licensure will not practice pharmacy while physically present in the State of Arkansas, from obtaining criminal background checks. (ii) However, before performing any practice of pharmacy while physically present within the State of Arkansas, such an applicant shall obtain the criminal background checks and be subject to the provisions of this section."
