AND

Delete the subtitle and substitute the following: "TO PROVIDE FOR A STUDY BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY AND DESIRABILITY OF CREATING AN ARKANSAS PHARMACY REIMBURSEMENT ALLOWANCE PROGRAM."

Delete section 1 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. <u>The Senate and House Interim Committees on Public Health</u>, Welfare, and Labor shall conduct a study to determine the feasibility and desirability of creating an Arkansas Pharmacy Reimbursement Allowance Program and present a comprehensive report of the findings to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Fifth General Assembly."
