Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1009.

Amend House Bill No. 1009 as engrossed, S1/16/04 (version: 01-16-2004 14:18):

Page 8, delete lines 6 through 21, and substitute: "SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-11-101(b), concerning the term of office of State Board of Education members, is amended as follows: (b)(1) The term of office of a member of the board, appointed prior to the effective date of subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section, shall be six (6) years. (2)(A) The term of office of the first member appointed after the effective date of this subdivision (b)(2)(A) shall be a single term of six (6) years and all other appointments after the effective date of this subdivision (b)(2)(A) shall be for a single term of seven (7) years. (B)(i) Any member appointed to the state board to fill a vacancy for an uncompleted term with fewer than three (3) years remaining on the original term may be reappointed to an additional term of seven (7) years. (ii) No member serving three (3) or more years on the state board may be reappointed.

(3) No current or new member shall be allowed to resign in order to be appointed to a new term on the board.

(4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to change the terms of any member of the state board that was appointed prior to the effective date of this subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section."
