Subtitle of House Bill No. 1024

"TO PROVIDE THAT AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING UNDER THE ARKANSAS CHILD
MALTREATMENT ACT SHALL BE IN PERSON."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1024.

Amend House Bill No. 1024 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11, delete "PERSON;" and substitute "PERSON OR BY VIDEO
CONFERENCE;"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO PROVIDE THAT AN ADMINISTRATIVE
HEARING UNDER THE ARKANSAS CHILD
MALTREATMENT ACT SHALL BE IN PERSON OR
BY VIDEO CONFERENCE."

AND

Page 2, delete line 12 and substitute the following:

"notification under this subsection (c), provided that the hearing officer
may conduct the hearing by video teleconference in lieu of an in-person
hearing. If neither party requests that the hearing be conducted in person,
then the hearing shall be conducted telephonically."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 17 through 33 and substitute the following:

"(f) If any party requests an in-person hearing within thirty (30)
days from the date that the party receives notification under subsection (c)
of this section, then the child maltreatment administrative hearing shall be
conducted at or from the location nearest to the party's residence. Such
locations shall include, but not be limited to:

- (1) Arkadelphia;
- (2) Booneville;
- (3) Conway;
- (4) Fayetteville;



- (5) Jonesboro;
- (6) Little Rock; or
- (7) Warren.”

AND

If appropriate, renumber the remaining sections of the bill
