Subtitle of House Bill No. 1162

"AN ACT FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION
DISABILITY DETERMINATION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007 BIENNIUM."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1162.

Amend House Bill No. 1162 as originally introduced:

Delete SECTIONS 3 and 4 of the bill in their entirety and substitute the following new section:

"SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

AND

Immediately after SECTION 5, add the following new sections to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
The remaining balance as of June 30, 2006, of unexpended appropriation in



Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into fiscal year 2006-07 to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.”

AND

Appropriately renumber the sections of the bill.
