Subtitle of House Bill No. 1184

"AN ACT TO ASSURE ELECTRONIC MONITORING AND OTHER METHODS OF JAIL
POPULATION MANAGEMENT ARE AUTHORIZED FOR ALL JAILS IN ARKANSAS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1184.

Amend House Bill No. 1184 as engrossed, H2/4/05 (version: 02-04-2005 09:17):

Page 2, immediately following Section 1, add a new section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 41, Subchapter 4, is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

12-41-405. Electronic monitoring of prisoners.

(a)(1) The chief of police, or his or her designee, may determine if a person convicted and sentenced to the city jail shall serve his or her sentence on electronic monitoring or on weekends if the determination does not conflict with any court orders.

(2) If the chief of police, or his or her designee, determines that a person convicted and sentenced to the city jail shall serve his or her sentence on electronic monitoring or on weekends, an agreement shall be entered into between the chief of police, or his or her designee, and the convicted person outlining the conditions of the sentence.

(b) If the convicted person fails to follow the conditions of the agreement, the chief of police, or his or her designee, shall have the authority to cancel the agreement and return the convicted person to the city jail by any lawful means necessary to serve the sentence."
