Subtitle of House Bill No. 1250

"AN ACT TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES
OBTAIN PERMITS OF APPROVAL."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1250.

Amend House Bill No. 1250 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 17 and substitute the following:

"(x) An assisted living facility in a county having
a population of seventy-five thousand (75,000) or more persons."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 25 through 32 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-10-1709 is amended to read as follows:
20-10-1709. Permit of approval.

(a) Facilities located in a county having a population of less than
seventy-five thousand (75,000) persons offering assisted living services ~~must~~
shall obtain a permit of approval.

(b)(1) ~~Provided, however, that~~ However, permits of approval held by
residential care facilities as of April 2, 2001, or held by subsequent
purchasers of those facilities, shall also be considered permits of approval
for assisted living without further action.

(2) However, residential care facilities that choose to offer
assisted living services are not exempted from assisted living licensure
requirements except as provided in § 20-10-1704."
