"AN ACT TO PROTECT THE CONTINUITY OF SCHOOL BOARDS BY AMENDING THE PROCEDURE FOR ELECTION OF SCHOOL BOARDS FOLLOWING ANNEXATION."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1266.

Amend House Bill No. 1266 as originally introduced:

Add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that local school boards of directors will be unstable if all members have terms that expire at the same time; that a procedure for members to draw lots will be necessary to avoid the instability; and that this act is immediately necessary because a procedure for drawing lots will need to be in place prior to the 2005 annual school elections. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
