Subtitle of House Bill No. 1343

"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF AGING AND
ADULT SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007 BIENNIUM."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1343.

Amend House Bill No. 1343 as engrossed, H2/21/05 (version: 02-21-2005 15:40)

Page 3, line 35, delete the underscores: “ _____ ”

AND

Page 3, delete line 36 in its entirety and substitute:

"(13) SENIOR CITIZEN CENTERS	<u>5,000,000</u>	<u>5,000,000</u>
TOTAL AMOUNT APPROPRIATED	<u>\$ 51,779,358</u>	<u>\$ 51,948,428</u>

AND

Insert an additional section immediately following SECTION 11 to read as follows:

“ SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENIOR CITIZEN CENTERS. The five million dollars (\$5,000,000) appropriated each fiscal year in this act for Senior Citizen Centers shall be distributed in the same manner as the funding formula requirements set out in the federal Older Americans Act funding law. The additional funding provided by this provision shall supplement and not supplant any monies currently funding services for Senior Citizen Centers.

The requirements in this section shall only be implemented in accordance with any necessary approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, and in the event that additional general revenue funding is provided by the General Assembly for these purposes. Should additional funding provided for these purposes be insufficient to provide for the increases in full, the increases shall be provided to the extent that funding is made available.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.”

AND

Appropriately renumber the subsequent sections of the bill.
