
Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1461.

Amend House Bill No. 1461 as engrossed, H2/11/05 (version: 02-11-2005 08:40):

Page 2, line 3 delete "the first day of the school year." and substitute "the first student-teacher interaction day of the school year, but no school district shall require certified personnel to work additional days that are not included in his or her contract unless the certified personnel is paid his or her daily rate of pay."

AND

- Page 2, delete line 6 entirely, and substitute the following: "requirements of subsection (a) of this section.
- (c) The State Board of Education shall promulgate the rules necessary for the proper implementation of this section.
- SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that school districts are currently entering into contracts for the professional development programs to be offered during the 2005-2006 school year; that school districts need sufficient time to plan and schedule professional development programs for certified personnel; and that this act is immediately necessary because a delay in its enactment may cause some districts to enter into unnecessary contracts for professional development programs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
 - (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
 - (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is



overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
