
Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1545.

Amend House Bill No. 1545 as originally introduced:

Delete SECTION 1 of the bill in its entirety and substitute the following new section:

"SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Department of Health for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

All unexpended general revenue funds received by the Department for this purpose shall be recovered at the end of each fiscal year as provided by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2003}{2005}$ through June 30, $\frac{2005}{2007}$."
