Subtitle of House Bill No. 1796

"TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENTS OF CORRECTION AND COMMUNITY
CORRECTION TO PROVIDE COUNTY JAIL REIMBURSEMENT INVOICES TO COUNTY
JUDGES AND TREASURERS AND TO PREPARE MONTHLY REIMBURSEMENT
REPORTS FOR EACH COUNTY."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1796.

Amend House Bill No. 1796 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 16 and substitute the following:
"AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE OPEN COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF
CORRECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY CORRECTION AND COUNTY OFFICIALS WITH
REGARD TO COUNTY JAIL REIMBURSEMENT AND RELATED MATTERS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 19 through 24 and substitute the following:
Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE OPEN COMMUNICATIONS
BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION,
THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY CORRECTION
AND COUNTY OFFICIALS WITH REGARD TO
COUNTY JAIL REIMBURSEMENT AND RELATED
MATTERS."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 3 through 29 and substitute the following:
"physically housed in the county jail.

(B) The Department of Correction and the Department of
Community Corrections shall, upon written request of a county judge, county
treasurer, or county sheriff, provide to the county official making the
request a written report summarizing the year-to-date county jail
reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded for verification by the
department and payment from the County Jail Reimbursement Fund. In addition,



the report shall include a summary of invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed.”
