"(3)(A) "Settlement" means an agreement between or among some or
all of the parties to a commission proceeding regarding the final resolution
of a proceeding or part of a proceeding following the completion of each
party's opportunity for discovery, analysis, and the development and filing
of each party's last written testimony with the commission.

"Settlement" does not include any communications (B) related to discovery, investigation, analysis, or the development of each party's position in a proceeding before the last written testimony is filed with the commission."

Page 2, line 11 delete "any party" and substitute "the general staff"

AND


Page 2, line 14 delete "in" and substitute "to"

AND

Page 2, delete line 15 and substitute "proceeding to participate in any settlement discussion in which the general staff participates."

AND

Page 2. delete lines 22 through 23 and substitute the following: "(e)(l)(A) Any party to a commission proceeding may file an objection to a settlement of that proceeding within ten (10) days after the settlement



was filed."

AND

Page 2, delete line 29 and substitute the following: "<u>her right to object or to cross examine any witnesses at any hearing on the</u> <u>settlement's</u>"
