Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1982.

Amend House Bill No. 1982 as originally introduced:

Delete the title in its entirety and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO CREATE THE TEACHER OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM AND THE DUAL CERTIFICATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS TO TEACHERS RETURNING TO COLLEGE TO RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL CERTIFICATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"AN ACT TO CREATE THE TEACHER OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM AND THE DUAL CERTIFICATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS TO TEACHERS RETURNING TO COLLEGE."

AND

Page 1, delete lines, 23 through 36 and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-81-601 is amended to read as follows: 6-81-601. Purpose.


There is an existing need in the state to enhance the academic expertise of employed teachers and administrators in Arkansas by providing opportunities for them to pursue additional college instruction related to their employment.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-81-602 is amended to read as follows: 6-81-602. Establishment.

There is established a program to be known as the Teacher and Administrator Enhancement and Retraining Grant Opportunity Program.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-81-603(a) is amended to read as follows:

(a) This Teacher and Administrator Enhancement and Retraining Grant Opportunity Program shall be administered by the Department of Higher



Education, which shall have the authority to establish necessary rules, regulations, procedures, and selection criteria for the administration of the program and to designate necessary forms and schedules.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code \S 6-81-604(1), pertaining to qualifications for teacher opportunity grants, is amended to read as follows:

(1) Grant recipients shall be bona fide residents of the State of Arkansas, as defined by the Department of Higher Education, and be eitizens of the United States or permanent resident aliens;

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code \S 6-81-605 is amended to read as follows: 6-81-605. Grants - Priority.

- (a) The first priority for the award of funds under the Teacher

 Opportunity Program is the award of scholarships under the Dual Certification

 Incentive Program, §§ 6-81-607 through 6-81-610. If funds are available

 after all awards are made under the Dual Certification Incentive Program,

 then additional grants may be made in accordance with the following:
- (a) (1) Students may receive grants up to but not in excess of the cost of student fees, books, and instructional supplies at the public institution of higher education in this state assessing the highest rate of student fees \div ; and
- $\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{(2)}}$ The grant or grants made to one (1) individual within one (1) fiscal year may not exceed the costs associated with six (6) semester credit hours or the equivalent of six (6) semester credit hours.
- (b) The Department of Higher Education shall determine priorities for awarding grants in the event there are more applicants than funds available. Priorities shall be determined in coordination with the Department of Education and shall be based on the needs of the state.
- (c) Should the number of the grant requests exceed funding available, priority will be given to those teachers or administrators who did not successfully complete tests of proficiency in basic academic skills or subject area content that teachers and administrators employed in the public schools may be required to take pursuant to state law or regulation of the State Board of Education."
