Amend House Bill No. 2481 as originally introduced: Page 2, delete line 33 and substitute: "school;" (22) An attorney who is currently employed with the Department of Human Services and has at least five (5) years of experience in juvenile court practice to be appointed by the Director of the Department of Human Services;" Page 2, line 34, delete "(22)" and substitute "(23)" Page 2, line 36, delete "(23)" and substitute "(24)" Page 3, delete lines 13 through 14 and substitute: "(d)(l) Except as provided in subdivision (d)(2) of this section, if a vacancy occurs on the commission, then the vacancy shall be filled by the same process as the original appointment. (2) If a judicial member of the commission recuses himself or herself from discussions or voting to preserve his or her impartiality in matters pending currently or likely to come before him or her in court, then the Chair of the Juvenile Code Revision Commission shall replace that member with a licensed attorney who has at least five (5) years of experience in the area of juvenile law and who is a citizen of the state."
