Subtitle of House Bill No. 2573

"TO PROVIDE AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF INCORPORATION AS A CITY OR
TOWN."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2573.

Amend House Bill No. 2573 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 24 through 31 and substitute:

"(a)(1) In addition to the procedures for incorporating a city or town under §§ 14-38-101 through 14-38-108, the inhabitants of a part of any county not embraced within the limits of any city or incorporated town may apply to the county judge of the proper county to call for an election on the issue of incorporating a city or town and for electing municipal officials if the following conditions are met:

(A) The territory proposed to be incorporated has at least four thousand (4,000) inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census; and

(B) The county judge is presented a written petition that:
(i) Meets the requirements of subdivision (a)(2) of
this section; and

(ii) Is signed by at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the qualified voters who reside in the territory proposed to be incorporated."

Page 2, line 26, delete "incorporation" and substitute "incorporation"
