Page 1, delete line 31 and 32, and substitute the following: "deviate sexual activity as defined in § 5-14-101; (2) Seduce, solicit, lure, or entice an individual that the person believes to be fifteen (15) years of age or younger in an effort to arrange a meeting with the individual for the purpose of engaging in sexual intercourse, sexually explicit conduct, or deviate sexual activity as defined in § 5-14-101; (3) Compile, transmit, publish, reproduce, buy, sell, receive,"
AND
Page 2, delete line 2, and substitute the following: "deviate sexual activity as defined in § 5-14-101; or (4) Compile, transmit, publish, reproduce, buy, sell, receive, exchange, or disseminate the name, telephone number, electronic mail address, residence address, picture, physical description, characteristics, or any other identifying information on an individual that the person believes to be fifteen (15) years of age or younger in furtherance of an effort to arrange a meeting with the individual for the purpose of engaging in sexual intercourse, sexually explicit conduct, or deviate sexual activity as defined in § 5-14-101."

Pate 2, delete lines 5 and 6, and substitute the following: "younger even if a meeting with the child never takes place.
