Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2665.

Amend House Bill No. 2665 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 16, delete "(2)(A)" and substitute "(C)"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 18 through 28 and substitute the following: "(2) The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall promulgate regulations prohibiting any person or entity from knowingly placing or disposing of lights containing mercury in a landfill after January 1, 2008. (3) (A) Each electric public utility shall offer a shielded lighting service option. (B) Not later than January 1, 2006, each electric public utility shall file an application with the Arkansas Public Service Commission

utility shall file an application with the Arkansas Public Service Commission to establish a schedule of rates and charges for the provision of a shielded lighting service option to the utility's customers.

(C) The Arkansas Public Service Commission shall require each electric public utility to inform its customers of the availability of the shielded lighting service."

AND

Page 3, delete lines 19 through 22 and substitute the following:
 "This chapter may be enforced by a town, city, or county of this state
by seeking injunctive relief in a court of competent jurisdiction."
