Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 2906.

Amend House Bill No. 2906 as engrossed, H3/15/05 (version: 03-15-2005 11:26):

Page 3, line 2, delete "possessing" and substitute "possessing exercising"

AND

Immediately following SECTION 2 add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1263 of 1993 is an act
that is important to public health and welfare of citizens located near high
impact solid waste management facilities. Ambiguities in the current
language of Act 1263 of 1993 impair the ability of the Arkansas Department of
Environmental Quality to protect the public health and welfare and a delay in
the effective date of this act could work irreparable harm upon the ability
of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality to effectively administer
its regulatory functions and properly implement the public health protections
provided through Act 1263 of 1993. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

- (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
- (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
