TO ADOPT LAW REGULATING AND TAXING CHARITABLE BINGO."

Amendment No. 3 to House Joint Resolution No. 1003.

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1003 as engrossed, H2/3/05 (version: 02-03-2005 09:04):

Add Senator Broadway as the Senate cosponsor

AND

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 13 and substitute:
"FOR A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW BINGO AND
RAFFLES TO BE CONDUCTED BY CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS; TO AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY TO ADOPT LAWS CONCERNING THE LICENSURE, REGULATION, OR TAXATION OF
BINGO AND RAFFLES."

AND

Page 1, delete line 17 and substitute:
"ALLOW BINGO AND RAFFLES TO BE CONDUCTED BY"

AND

Page 1, delete line 21 and substitute:
"BINGO AND RAFFLES."

AND

Page 1, line 36, delete "Authorized bingo organization" and substitute
"Authorized bingo and raffles organization"

AND

Page 2, line 5, delete "bingo; and" and substitute "bingo or raffles;"

AND



Page 2, delete line 14 and substitute:

"competition among all players in the game; and

(3) "Raffle" means the selling of tickets or chances to win a prize awarded through a random drawing."

AND

Page 2, delete line 15 and substitute:

"(b)(1) The game of bingo or raffles conducted by an authorized bingo and raffles organization"

AND

Page 2, line 18, delete "the game" and substitute "the game or raffle"

AND

Page 2, line 20, delete "authorized bingo" and substitute "authorized bingo and raffles"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 22 through 24 and substitute the following:

"(c) The General Assembly shall provide by law for the licensure and regulation of authorized bingo and raffles organizations to conduct the game or bingo or raffles and may levy taxes on the activities."
