Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 1029 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF HOMICIDE BY CHILD ABUSE." 

## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1029.

Amend Senate Bill No. 1029 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

- "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
  - 5-10-107. Homicide by child abuse.
  - (a) As used in this section:
- (1) "Abuse" means an act or omission defined under § 12-12-503(2) as abuse;
  - (2) "Child" means a child under twelve (12) years of age;
- (3) "Neglect" means an act or omission defined under § 12-12-503(12) as neglect;
- (4) "Pattern or practice" means one (1) or more previous episodes of similar conduct;
- (5) "Sexual abuse" means an act defined under § 12-12-503(17) as sexual abuse; and
- (6) "Torture" means the intentional infliction of extreme physical pain upon a child for the sole purpose of inflicting pain.
- (b) A person commits the offense of homicide by child abuse if the person:
- (1) Causes the death of a child while engaging in an act of torture of the child;
- (2) Causes the death of a child while committing the offense of abuse or sexual abuse against the child, and the child's death occurs under circumstances that manifest an extreme indifference to human life;
- (3) Causes the death of a child as a result of a pattern or practice of neglect of the child; or
- (4) Knowingly aids or abets another person to commit abuse, sexual abuse, or neglect and the abuse, sexual abuse, or neglect results in the death of a child.
- (c)(l) A person violating the provisions of subdivision (b)(l) of this section is guilty of a Class Y felony and upon conviction shall be punished in accordance with the laws of this state.
  - (2) A person violating the provisions of subdivision (b)(2) of

this section is guilty of a Class A felony and upon conviction shall be punished in accordance with the laws of this state.

- (3) A person violating the provisions of subdivision (b)(3) of this section is guilty of a Class C felony and upon conviction shall be punished in accordance with the laws of this state.
- (4) A person violating the provisions of subdivision (b)(4) of this section is guilty of a Class D felony and upon conviction shall be punished in accordance with the laws of this state."
