Amend Senate Bill No. 1061 as originally introduced:

Page 4, line 12, delete "program" and substitute "program as prescribed and approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the Department of Transportation"

AND

Page 12, line 2, delete "one (1)" and substitute "one hundred eighty (180) days"

AND


Page 12, line 3, delete "year" entirely

AND

Page 21, delete line 31 and substitute: "provisions of \S 5-65-206 shall apply in the circuit court proceeding.

SECTION 12. Sections 1 through 11 of this act are contingent upon the approval by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the Department of Transportation of the transdermal alcohol monitoring program and alternative sentencing provisions set forth in Sections 1 through 11 of this act, approval of a waiver for Sections 1 through 11 of this act, or approval of a pilot program for the implementation and administration of Sections 1 through 11 of this act.

SECTION 13. The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police shall negotiate and consummate a waiver, a pilot program, or both with the



National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the Department of Transportation regarding Sections 1 through 11 of this act."
