Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1077.		
Amend Senate Bill No. 1077 as originally introduced:		

Immediately following SECTION 1, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the ability of real estate professionals to assist courts in determining the value of property is hampered under current law and that this act will enable courts to better utilize the testimony of realtors in appropriate cases. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

- (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
- (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
