Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1156.
Amend Senate Bill No. 1156 as originally introduced:
Delete everything after the Enacting Clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Tire Safety Act of 2005".
SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 37, Subchapter 4 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows: 27-37-403. (a) No person shall sell, offer for sale, give away, or have in his or her possession with intent to sell or give away a tire for use on any motor vehicle, all-terrain vehicle, farm tractor, motorized off-road equipment, or trailer, if the tire has been marked "blem", "second", "imperfect", or any similar appropriate descriptive term. (b) A violation of this section is a Class B misdemeanor."
