Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 1195

"AN ACT TO CLARIFY ELIGIBILITY FOR AND SERVICE ON THE ARKANSAS STATE
MEDICAL BOARD."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1195.

Amend Senate Bill No. 1195 as originally introduced:

Add Representative J. Johnson as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 3, delete lines 21 through 33 and substitute the following:

"(g)(1) Members of the board may be removed from the office by the Governor:

(A) For good cause pursuant to § 25-16-804;

(B) For cause including dishonorable or unprofessional conduct, abuse of authority, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance; or

(C)(i) For any reason that would justify probation, suspension, or revocation of a physician's license to practice medicine under the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-401 et seq. which shall be referred directly to the Division of Pharmacy Services and Drug Control of the Department of Health by the Governor for the investigation as provided in § 17-80-106.

(ii) The division shall prepare a report for the Governor based on their findings.

(2) No member of the board may be involved in the conduct of the investigation except to cooperate with the investigation as required by the investigator."
