Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 156.
Amend Senate Bill No. 156 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete lines 19 through 31 and substitute the following: "(12) Any person to use an Arkansas address, including a return address, in any solicitation unless: (A) the charitable organization maintains and staffs an office at that address; (B) the solicitation discloses in writing immediately proximate to the address located in this state, both the address of the charitable organization's actual headquarters and the fact that the address is that of a mail drop box or located in a mail-handling facility; or (C) the person, if soliciting by phone, discloses the address of the organization's actual headquarters in addition to any address maintained in this state."
