| Page 1, delete line 31 and substitute the following: "(c) If an autopsy is required under § 12-12-318 and the coroner" |

| Page 2, delete lines 1 through 31 and substitute the following: "(d)(1) If the coroner is considering withholding one (1) or more parts of a potential donor for any reason, the coroner shall consult with the chief medical examiner or his or her designee. (2) If after consulting with the chief medical examiner or his or her designee, the coroner denies removal of the part or parts, he or she shall explain in writing the reasons for the denial and shall be present during the removal of the part or parts. (e) At the request of the coroner, or in the case in which the autopsy is performed by someone other than the coroner, a document shall be filed with the coroner detailing the condition of the part or parts removed and the relationship, if any, to the cause of death." |
