Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 196

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THREE (3) YEARS OF INTERNSHIP OR RESIDENCY FOR
FOREIGN APPLICATIONS FOR MEDICAL LICENSURE."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 196.

Amend Senate Bill No. 196 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 6 through 8 and substitute the following:

"(b) He or she must also have:

(1) ~~served one (1) year~~ Served three (3)
years as an intern or resident in an accredited medical school-affiliated
hospital in the United States postgraduate medical education program in the
United States; or

(2) Completed one (1) year as an intern
or resident in an accredited postgraduate medical education program in the
United States and be currently enrolled in an accredited postgraduate medical
program in Arkansas."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 10 through 12 and substitute the following:

"may require of all applicants for licensure:

(i) ~~a~~ A properly verified certificate that they have
served one (1) year of internship in a general accredited hospital; or

(ii) A certificate of their service in an accredited
postgraduate medical education program as described in subdivision
(b)(3)(A)(iii)(b) of this section; and"
