Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 315

"TO REQUIRE THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE TO GIVE NOTICE OF CHANGES IN
THE DRIVING LAWS TO ALL PERSONS WHO REGISTER OR RENEW THEIR
REGISTRATION FOR MOTOR VEHICLES AND APPLY FOR OR RENEW DRIVER' S
LICENSES."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 315.

Amend Senate Bill No. 315 as originally introduced::

Page 1, delete lines 12 through 15, and substitute the following:
"THE DRIVING LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:
"TO REQUIRE THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE
TO GIVE NOTICE OF CHANGES IN THE DRIVING
LAWS."

AND

Page 1, delete line 31 and substitute the following:
"(a)(1) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 35 and 36, and substitute the following:
"(2) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the
Department of Finance and Administration shall make the website address
related to the information required under subsection (a)(1) of this section
available at all state revenue offices.
(b)(1) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the
Department of Finance and Administration shall by July 1 of each year prepare
a list and explanation of the most violated driving or traffic laws during
the previous year.
(2) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the
Department of Finance and Administration shall make the information required
under subsection (b)(1) of this section available at all state revenue



offices and on its website.

(c) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to promulgate rules to administer the provisions of this subchapter."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 8.

AND

Page 2, delete line 13 and substitute the following:

"(a)(1) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 17 through 26, and substitute the following:

"(2) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall make the website address related to the information required under subsection (a)(1) of this section available at all state revenue offices.

(b)(1) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall by July 1 of each year prepare a list and explanation of the most violated driving or traffic laws during the previous year.

(2) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall make the information required under subsection (b)(1) of this section available at all state revenue offices and on its website.

(c) The Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to promulgate rules to administer the provisions of this subchapter."
