Page 3, delete line 14 and substitute: "inappropriate over-the-counter drug to a child and the child is detrimentally impacted by the overdose or the over-the-counter drug;"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 27 and 28 and substitute: "child when it is reasonable and moderate and is inflicted by a parent or guardian for purposes of restraining"

AND

Page 5, delete line 36 and substitute: "clothing, shelter, and education required by law, excluding the"

AND


Page 6, delete line 6 and substitute: "juvenile from abandonment, abuse, sexual abuse,"

AND

Page 15, line 24, delete "thirty (30)" and substitute "fourteen (14)"

Page 18, delete lines 34 through 35 entirely

Page 24, delete lines 11 through 21 and substitute: "(e) Schools, residential facilities, hospitals, and other places that a child may be located shall not require a written court order for the department to take a seventy-two (72) hour hold under this section, § 9-27-313, or § 12-12-516."

AND

Delete Section 16 entirely

AND

If appropriate, renumber the remaining sections of the bill
