Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 444

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR DETENTION OF A PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE (21)
YEARS FOR ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE ALCOHOL WITH FALSE IDENTIFICATION
AND TO AUTHORIZE AN ARREST FOR AN ATTEMPTED PURCHASE OF ALCOHOL
WITH FALSE IDENTIFICATION."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 444.

Amend Senate Bill No. 444 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 18, and substitute the following:

"certified law enforcement officer to conduct an investigation.

(iii) The detention authorized under subdivision
(a)(3)(A)(ii) of this section shall not include a physical detention.

(iv) If the seller of alcoholic beverages or the
seller's employee attempts to verify the age of the person attempting to
purchase alcoholic beverages by way of photographic identification and
complies with the provisions of subdivisions (a)(3)(A)(ii) and (iii) of this
section, the detention"
