
Page 24, line 35, delete "2005" and substitute "2007"

Add new sections immediately following Section 15 to read as follows: "SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the following classifications:

Counselor School for Math & Science	7612
Dorm Supv. School for Math & Science	7613

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005 June 30, 2007.

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER GRANT RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and Sciences who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/12 of their annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as



exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. The additional compensation authorized by this section shall only be paid from a portion of the grant monies received and shall not be paid from state general revenues or Educational Excellence Trust Fund monies.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007."
