**Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 51.**

Amend Senate Bill No. 51 as engrossed, S2/1/05 (version: 02-01-2005 08:55)::

Page 1, delete lines 29 through 36 and substitute the following:

"(1) "Motor vehicle data recorder" means a factory-installed device in a motor vehicle that:

(A) Records, stores, transmits, or dispenses any of the following information for the purpose of retrieval after a collision:

- (i) Vehicle speed;
- (ii) Vehicle direction;
- (iii) Vehicle location;
- (iv) Steering performance; or
- (v) Seatbelt restraint status;

(B) Has the capacity to transmit information concerning a collision in which the motor vehicle has been involved to a central communications system when a crash occurs; and

(C) Includes a sensing and diagnostic module;"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 8

AND

Page 2, line 9, delete "(3)" and substitute "(2)"

AND

Page 3, line 7, delete "of the accident" and substitute "the data is accessed"
