WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE."

Amendment No. 6 to Senate Bill No. 51.

Amend Senate Bill No. 51 as engrossed, S2/23/05 (version: 02-23-2005 08:45):

Page 1, line 31, delete "device" and substitute "feature"

AND

Page 1, line 33, delete "collision" and substitute "crash"

AND

Page 2, line 4, delete "collision" and substitute "crash"

AND

Page 2, delete line 14 and substitute the following:

"(b) At the time of new vehicle purchase by a consumer from a dealership, an owner of a motor vehicle"

AND

Page 2, line 21 delete "stored" and substitute "recorded, stored, or transmitted"

AND

Page 3, line 33 delete "obtain" and substitute "retrieve"

AND

Page 4, line 6 delete "use" and substitute "retrieval"

AND



Page 4 delete lines 25 through 29 and substitute the following:

“(j)(1) If a motor vehicle is equipped with a motor vehicle event data recorder that is capable of recording, storing, transmitting, or dispensing information as described in this section and that capability is part of a subscription service, that the information may be recorded, stored, transmitted or dispensed shall be disclosed in the subscription agreement.

(2) Subsections (c), (d), (f), (g), and (h) shall not apply to subscription services that meet the requirements of this subsection (j).”

If appropriate, renumber the remaining sections of the bill
