"TO CLARIFY THE REDETERMINATION OF BENEFITS UNDER THE ARKANSAS
JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 64.
Amend Senate Bill No. 64 as originally introduced:
Delete Section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following:
"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-8-715 is repealed. 24-8-715. Redetermination of benefits.
(a) Each July 1 the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System shall redetermine the amount of each monthly benefit which has been payable by the
system under the Tier Two Actual Judicial Service Benefit Plan for at least
twelve (12) full calendar months. The redetermined amount shall be payable
for the following twelve (12) calendar months.
(b) Subject to the maximum stated in subsection (c) of this section,
the redetermined amount shall be the amount of benefit payable as of the
immediately preceding July 1 increased by three percent (3%).
(c) In no event shall the redetermined amount be more than the amount
of the benefit payable as of the immediately preceding July 1 multiplied by
the following fraction:
(1) The numerator shall be the average of the consumer price
index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year immediately
preceding July 1, but in no event an amount less than the denominator; and (2) The denominator shall be the average of the consumer price
index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year second
preceding the redetermination date.
