Amend Senate Bill No. 74 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 5 and substitute the following: "planned to culminate in the termination of a pregnancy in this state; (3) "Gestational age" means the age of the unborn child as calculated from the first day of the last menstrual period of the pregnant woman;"

AND

Page 2, line 6, delete "(3)" and substitute"(4)"

AND

Page 2, line 13, delete "(4)" and substitute"(5)"

Page 2, line 17, delete "(5)" and substitute"(6)"

AND


Page 2, line 21, delete "(6)" and substitute"(7)"

Page 7, delete lines 24 through 36

AND

Page 8, delete line 1 and substitute the following: "20-16-1109. Penalties. (a) A person who knowingly or recklessly performs or attempts to



perform a termination of a pregnancy in violation of this subchapter shall be subject to disciplinary action by the Arkansas State Medical Board.

(b) No penalty may be assessed against the woman upon whom the abortion is performed or attempted to be performed.

(c) No penalty or civil liability may be assessed for failure to comply with any provision of this subchapter unless the department has made the printed materials available at the time that the physician or the physician's agent is required to inform the woman of her right to review them."
